Oyinlola's convoy kills two motorcyclists

The incident happened at about 3:00 p.m on Ikirun-Osogbo Road when one of the vehicles in the convoy which was on top speed, allegedly ran into the men killing them instantly.

Eyewitness said the tragedy happened when the driver of the car was trying to avoid a pothole. It was said that the car did not wait to attend to the victims whose bodies were thrown into the bush by the impact of the accident.

Some sympathisers, who came to the scene, rescued the victims. They brought them out of the bush, only to discover that they were dead. It was said that the tragedy could have been avoided if the driver had been more careful.

When contacted, the Press Secretary, to the Governor, Mr Kayode Oladeji who confirmed the incident, however, said the governor was not in the convoy when it happened.

According to him, the driver may have been sent on an errand when the incident happened.
