

Two killed in Benin clash

TWO persons yesterday lost their lives in a fight in Benin, Edo State. The clash was between Chief, John Osamede Adun (aka Bob Izua) boys and Revenue Mobilisation Contractors at Oredo Local Government.

Several others were injured before security agents brought it under control.

The Nation learnt that the Oredo Council Chairman, Victor Enoghamah, has contracted revenue collection to a private contractors and this decision caused a friction between the firm and the former collectors - the Bob Izua Boys.

The Revenue Mobilisations collectors were allegedly prevented from their rounds yesterday by the Bob Izua Boys and fight broke out which led to the death of the two.
