ing up, Sikiru was reported to have <u>refused</u> on the ground that <u>N40</u> too <u>much</u> for the journey and insisted

on paying only N20.
Following his stance, a fight broke out between both men.

It was during the fight that Omitude hit Sikiru with an iron rod on the head. The victim, it was learnt,

died as he was being rushed to the hospital.
