

Four feared killed in Ilorin

THE police in Kwara State have arrested four persons over the violent clash in which four persons were feared killed and property worth millions of naira damaged in Ilorin.

Spokesman for the command, Mr. Markus Gideon, said yesterday the police were still in search of one person said to be the arrowhead of the attack.

Gideon did not confirm the source of the fray, but independent sources claimed it had to do with the crisis within an unidentified party.

The police spokesman also refused to confirm whether one of the victims was a police officer who was want to quell the clash. The clash, which took residents unawares, occurred at Adabata in Ilorin on

It was not clear what led to the crisis. But insinuations were rife that it was as result of differences in opinion between two leading politicians from the area. Early this week, the immediate past Special Assistant to Governor Bukola Saraki on Poverty Alleviation Programme, Alhaji Bibire Ajape had escaped death narrowly when people suspected to be assassins stormed his private home.

The incident, which took place a few hours to his being sworn-in as the Chairman, Transition Implementation Committee (TIC) for Ilorin East Local Government Council area was said to have been perpetrated by of hoodlums.
