

Woman to appear in court over death of policeman

ILORIN

THE police in Ilorin, Kwara State say a female worker of the Pharmacology Department, University of Ilorin, will soon be docked for allegedly causing the death of a policeman through reckless driving.

According to the police first information report the suspect had on April 8 driven her Nissan Maxima car with registration number CY 745 ABJ, recklessly on Offa Road, Ilorin.

The report alleged that the suspect, whose name was being withheld, hit the policeman Idris Abdulrasaq, who was on his motorcycle.

The report further alleged that the suspect drove dangerously without regard to the condition, nature and the volume of traffic on the highway.

It said she left her lane opposite the government printing press on Offa road and hit a Jincheng motorcycle, which the late constable was riding.

The constable, who was attached to the 'A' Divisional Police Station, sustained serious injuries because of the accident, leading to his death at the University of Ilorin Teaching Hospital, the report added. No date has been fixed for the mention of the case which was registered at an Ilorin Court Registry.
