

One killed in Lagos clash

ONE person was killed yesterday in Obalende area of Lagos when two rival groups of commercial motorcyclists clashed.

The Nation gathered that trouble started on Tuesday as some union leaders decided to take over the part belonging to riders operating from the fort of the bridge opposite the Nigeria Police Community Bank.

However, the union leaders encountered a stiff resistance resulting to a fight.

It was further gathered that the union leaders regrouped yesterday with some miscreants for another round of fight leading to the death of one of the operators under the bridge.

The Command spokesman, Mr Olubode Ojajuni, a Superintendent of Police (SP) confirmed the incident. He said case is under investigation.
