

Assassins kill Dutch national

UNKNOWN assassins have killed a Port Harcourt-based Dutch national, Mr. Tony Kouwanhoven, over a business that went awry.

Kouwanhoven was said to have been killed on Sunday morning in his 79, Evo Road, New GRA, Port Harcourt home by the unknown assailants. They removed nothing from his house, it was learnt.

Kouwanhoven, proprietor of Blue Café Restaurant on Olu Obasanjo Street, Port Harcourt where he lived for a long time, would have easily passed off as a Nigerian if not for his colour, according to resi-

dents.

What gave an inkling into the motive behind his assassination was a note left by his killers who claimed that they gave Kouwanhoven \$50,000 to buy them cars but he neither refunded the money nor bought the cars.

Commissioner of Police Mr. Felix Ogbaudu said: "He was killed this morning. My men are there to tidy up things and take his body to the mortuary."

Kouwanhoven's body, it was learnt, showed that he was shot at close range. There was no sign of a scuffle.
