NO fewer than four students were feared dead at the weekend at the

at the weekend at the Ozoro Polytechnics, Delta State following a clash

with the police.

One of the victims was said to be a female stu-

dent who drowned while trying to escape.
Three male students were hit by stray bullets

it was not certain who fired the shots.

Trouble broke out when the school authorities called in the police to quash protest by students who were prevented from

writing their examinations.

The student, who were yet to pay their school fees, were barred from

fees, were barred from writing the examinations.
However, the matter took a turn for the worse

when the students stormed the examination hall in protest.

The school has been

shut to prevent further loss of lives. The police imagemaker, Assistant Superintendent Ishaku

Superintendent Ishaku
Banawi, denied the death
of any student.

He, however confirmed
that policemen were

that policemen were deployed to maintain peace in the school. There was no such thing; what happened was that there was a protest which threatened to get

rowdy. The police were called in and they handled the situation without firing any shot,:" he said.
