killed him during a gun duel.

Mr. Ishaku Banawi, police spokesman, confirmed the incident. He said: "The hoodlums were sighted in a nearby bush in Ibusa town preparing to carry out a rob-

He explained that security agents responded to a distress call and rushed to the scene but were engaged in a gun battle that led to the killing of one of the gang members while others took to their heels.
