

4 kids died in fire outbreak

FIRE accident erupted at 23, Obashola Ajibola, Aguda, Surulere, Lagos thereby causing the death of four Children at around 8:00p.m on December 7th 2007.

According to one of the residents, who declined mentioning her name, the children were the grandchildren of the Landlady, Mrs Adebayo, a widow.

Speaking further, she said that the victims included a set of twins and the two younger siblings.

"Our landlady is now destabilized due to this unfortunate accident death of her grandchildren", she said. She expressed surprise at the fire-break out saying "something like that has never happened before".

Speaking in the same vein, another witness and a very good neighbour to Mrs Adebayo said that the landlady was sitting downstairs during the time when the accident happened and her four grandchildren were fast asleep upstairs.

The Landlady was said to have ran upstairs and beckoned to people for help when the fire had already taken over the building.

Mrs Adebayo promptly called the police men and one of her children that stay around that area the witness said "you need to see the way the old woman was rolling on the floor even to the gutter in front of the building".
