

# Two die in wedding tragedy

**A** WEDDING at Muva village in Mubi North Local Government Area of Adamawa State has claimed two lives when a man allegedly stabbed another in the gathering, to death. He was lynched.

The alleged attacker, a herdsman, was lynched to death following the death of his victim.

Sources said the herdsman had left his sleeping

cattle in a nearby bush to join merry-makers of the Fali tribe in a wedding feast but got drunk after a heavy consumption of *burukutu*, a local brew.

The drunk man allegedly became drunk, excited and dangled his sword in merriment.

Disturbed by the development, some youths decided to drag him out of the dance floor, thus

incurring his anger and leading to his stabbing a youth to death.

The development led to others lynching the herdsman.

The Police Area Commander in Mubi, Mr Saliu Kashim, said he was on vacation.

However, the Divisional Police Officer (DPO), Mr Alfa Jibrin, said he was still waiting for details of the incident

from the Muva Police outpost.

Meanwhile, the Principal Medical Officer at Mubi General Hospital, Dr Pius Tizhe, confirmed receiving two bodies from Muva.

The Administrator of Mubi North Development Area, Mr Kevin Peters, has summoned a security meeting to douse rising tension between Fulani nomads and Fali tribesmen.
