Herds of cattle, several vehicles and shops were burnt. The incident

resulted in heavy traffic around the Opic Plaza as motorists in a bid to escape faced on-coming vehicles.

The Head of Operations, FRSC, Mr Habu Dauda said besides the tanker driver, no other person was killed.
