## 2 killed in Ajah over land tussle

■ WO persons were killed on Thursday and others injured in a clash between two groups over a parcel of land in Ajah, Mr Frank Mba, the Lagos State Police Public Relations

Officer, confirmed the inci-dent today, saying that two persons had been arrested in

connection with the incident. Mba said that the two persons, who were arrested with

cutlasses hidden under their clothes, would be prosecuted and that investigation into the crisis had commenced. Eve-witnesses said that trou-

ble started when the groups had a disagreement at the lo-cation of the land, which later resulted to a free-for-all. They claimed that during the

fight, some young men, believed to be loyal to a popular traditional ruler in the area, used dangerous weap-

"As the fight raged, some residents sustained injuries from the cutlasses, bullets and broken bottles used during the fight," one of the eve-witnesses said.

The witness also said that during the fight, vehicles on Ajah road were forced to turn back as people scampered for

It will be record that the Ajah community has been a hot spot since the past five years because of a dispute between two popular families over the land.
