

Six arraigned for murder of US-based bishop

SIX persons were on Monday arraigned for allegedly killing Bishop Ogbonnaya Onye-wububu, an Anglican Bishop based in the United States.

The accused persons, included Chinedu Nnadumele, Chibuike Ubani, Ahamefule Arisa, Uchechukwu Ogbonna, Adanma Arisa and Oko Rachael.

They allegedly shot and killed the Bishop while robbing him of N20,000 cash and a Nokia handset.

They were also said to have robbed his sister Lilian, of her Nokia hand-

set and a VCD player.

The robbery took place at Azumiri, Umukabia, in Umuahia North Local Government Area of Abia State, according to the prosecution.
