

One killed in Ondo drivers' clash

A CRISIS between two factions of the National Union of Road Transport Workers (NURTW) in Ipele/Iyere branch, Owo Local Government Area of Ondo state yesterday claimed one life.

The crisis was as a result of change in leadership.

The house of the former Minister of State for Education, Dr. Adewumi Abitoye, was torched and property worth millions of naira were destroyed as guns axes, cutlasses, charms and knives were freely used.

Already, the House of Assembly has intervened to forestall the spread to other parts of the state.

Tension was high in Ipele when *The Nation* visited the community as residents remained indoors for fear of attack by rival union members.
