ARMED robbers yester-day stormed the Alapere Ketu Lagos

branch of a third generation bank, killing five persons and wounding 15 others.

The robbers, who defied the rain, blew up the bank's

electronic door with expolisives.

A woman, described as the branch manager, was shot on the chest and a 12-year-old. boy, who came to the bank

Residents said the police

arrived on the scene two hours after the hoodlums had gone. A police station is said to be about 300 metres away from

the scene. The hoodlums, said to be

more than 20, came in three vehicles and went straight to business. It was gathered that

they took over Demurin

Street, which links Ketu to Alapere and shot sporadically into the air. Evewitnesses told our cor-

respondent that when they

got to the bank, the fired at

the door, but it did not open.

They then blew it open with explosives. On entering the banking hall, they shot at the officials who wanted to stop them from gaining access to the

vault.

In the process, the manager was shot on the chest, some workers and customers were also hit. An undisclosed amount of money was alleged to have
