Killer-syrup: Two die in Osun

THE National Agency for Foods, Drugs Ad-ministration and Control

(NAFDAC) in Osun State has seized 131 bottles of the killer-syrup, My Pikin, from chemists and pharmacies.

The seizure followed the death of two children in the last three weeks due to complications from the poisonous syrup.

The state's Head of NAFDAC, Mrs. Yeduni Adenuga, said the syrup tested positive to the poisonous chemical contained in the killer-syrup.

University of Technology Teaching Hospital in Osogbo, Dr.

Olusola Oyedeji, said the hospital referred the first victim of the poisonous drug to Obafemi Awolowo

Teaching Hospital, Ile-Ife. Oyedeji said the child died at the Ile-Ife hospital, five davs after his referral.

He said the second death was

recorded last week.
