## Eight feared killed as robbers strike in Edo

IGHT persons, including some policemen, were feared yesterday when armed robbers struck in Edo State.

Delta State Police Commissioner Joseph Oshiomogho, whose convoy was also attacked, escaped unhurt.

But some of his aides were killed.

Among those killed was a driver of a first generation

bank.

A bullion van was also attacked.

The driver, who was said to have been shot in the head, was attcked on James Watt Road, Benin-City.

Sources said the cream colour bullion van was attacked with a police pick-up van at Ologbo Junction, a boundary town between Delta and Edo states.

The hoodlums were armed with oxy-acetylene gas cylinders with which they tried to open the bullion van, it was learnt.

A source said: "The operation lasted for over one hour and all vehicles coming from Benin and the opposite

Yet, another source, who later visited the scene at about 4:00p.m., said the police van was riddled with bullet.

Oshiomogho was attacked at Igueben, an Edo community. Some hoodlums reportedly

opened fire on his vehicle.

The attack on the police boss is the second in less than one month.

His convoy was attacked at Igbanke, also in Edo State last month.

The Assistant Inspector-General of Police (AIG) in charge of the zone, Suleiman Faki, blamed the rising crime rate on the lack of adequate Armed Personnel Carriers (APCs).
