

Police kill two robbery suspects, arrest five

Two suspected armed robbers were killed and five others arrested by the Ogun State Police Command.

They met their waterloo while carrying out robbery operations in some parts of the state.

Police kill two robbery suspects, arrest five

One of the suspected robbers was shot dead during a gun duel with the police.

They had snatched a Kia Picanto car, with registration number Lagos DJ 758 KSF at Atan in Ijebu North East Local Government Area, and made to escape through Oke-Eri.

The other was killed in a robbery incident on Agoro Road, Ijoko -Ota.

The five suspects were arrested at Agbado when a patrol team accosted a Mitsubishi L300 marked FX 141 KJA in which they rode in.

The Command spokesman Mr. Olumuyiwa Adejobi gave the name of the suspects as Oyekunle Olakunle, Tijani Aderemi, Olaniyan Wasiu, Bamgbose Tunde and Opeyemi Aremu.

Adejobi said one locally made pistol and live cartridges were recovered from the suspects.

He said they (the suspects) were assisting the police on how to track down other members of the gang.
