There was pandemonium at Okegwe district in Okene Local Government Area of Kogi State, when some irate youths beheaded Mallam Abdul Musa (28) at his residence.

Acting Commissioner of Police Alhaji Magaji Abdullahi told reporters that 18 suspects have been arraigned.

The killing, which took place on Monday, was allegedly master-minded by a top official of Okene Local Government Area who is currently in detention.

The Nation

gathered that a former senatorial candidate of the Peoples Democratic Party (PDP) was also arrested.

The deceased's elder brother, Mallam Idris Musa, said the victim was law-abiding.

He claimed that his brother's body is yet to be found.

He called on security operatives to punish the culprits.

A Magistrate Court in Lokoja, the state capital, has remanded the 18 suspects at Koton Karfe Prison Yard.

Magistrate Joel Babatunde adjourned the case till January 6, 2010.
