One dead in Kano police/students clash

At least one person died at the weekend during a clash between the police and students of the School of Environmental Studies, Gwarzo, Kano State.

The students have protested against the murder of their colleague, Aliyu S. Aliyu, who was believed to have died during a fracas between them and students of the Government Secondary School, Gwarzo.

They asked the police to produce Aliyu's killer.

The demonstration turned sour between when the students attempted to burn the police station.

The police promptly disperse them with tear gas and sporadically shooting into the air.

The deceased, Attahiru Tahir, was hit by stray bullet in the process.

Police spokesman Baba Mohammed Azare, who confirmed the incident, said the situation has been brought under control.
