Suspected robbers attack two banks in Ilesa, shoot manager

Suspected robbers attack two banks in Ilesa, shoot manager

An armed gang yesterday attacked two commercial banks in Ilesa, Osun State, shooting one of the bank managers at close range for allegedly failing to quickly open the vault for them.

The robbers, numbering about 10, were reported to have struck at two new generation banks in Isokun area of the town around 11am.

Investigation showed that one of the bank managers, who was critically injured and is currently receiving treatment in an undisclosed hospital, was shot because he could not immediately open the bank's vault for the impatient robbers.

About five people, including customers and a policeman attached to one of the banks, were shot as the robbers were fleeing.

The police, however, caught them as they attempted to escape from the town. They are at the state Police Command.

Public Relations Officer for Command, Mr Clement Akinola confirmed the incident but did not comment further on it.
