**Three** persons were feared dead yesterday and scores of others injured in a **violence** that engulfed **Ijoko-Ota** in Ado-Odo –Ota Local Government Area of Ogun State.

The mayhem that reportedly lasted over minutes, was said to have begun by with a shootout.

*The Nation* gathered that trouble started around 11 am when unknown gunmen drove into the residence of one Bashiru, called him out and allegedly shot him. Part of the bullets reportedly hit his wife who was following him.

It was gathered Bashiru dropped dead instantly in his compound, while his wife lay critically wounded.

There were heightened anxiety over her condition as at noon yesterday.

Eyewitness said the hoodlums and urchins, who were irked by the killing, quickly seized the opportunity to wreck havoc on residents and visitors to the area, looting and vandalising properties.

The Police Command's Public Relations Officer, Mr. Olumuyiwa Adejobi, a Deputy Superintendent of Police, confirmed the disturbance, saying only one person was **killed**.

According to Adejobi, Bashiru was gunned down in front of his house by people suspected to be assailants in the presence of his wife, adding that the incident occurred during a free-for-all fight.
