Suicide pastor kills wife, baby in Akwa Ibom

The police in Akwa Ibom State are still trying to unravel why Pastor Brown Betta killed his wife, his baby and eventually stabbed himself to death.

Police spokesman Gab Ngan said some people have been arrested, but there is still no clue as to why such incident happened

The late Brown was a pastor in one of the Pentecostal churches in Uyo.

The late Mrs. Brown worked at the State Polytechnic, Ikot Osurua in Ikot Ekpene Local Government.

Brown's landlord, Mr. James Atakpa, said he was shocked since the deceased was not known to be violent.

According to him, the late Brown had just returned from his village in Eket Local Government Area a week ago, called his wife in and locked the door

"The next thing we heard was a loud shout from within the house. Before neighbours could come, he had smashed the baby's head several times on the wall, stabbed the wife repeatedly and proceeded to stab himself to death," Atakpa said.

A source said the late Brown found out that he was not the father of the baby and questioned his wife, who denied it

The late Brown, according to him, had queried the baby's complexion.

"The late Brown, I think, killed his wife because of jealousy because he always accused her of flirting," he said.
