Three feared dead in Kwara auto crash

Three feared dead in Kwara auto crash

No fewer than three persons in the early hours of yesterday died in a road accident on the Oloru-Bode Sa'adu-Jebba Road, Kwara State.

An eyewitness blamed the accident on the driver of a trailer who parked carelessly by the roadside.

The victims died on the spot.

The truck's driver was said to have lost the control of his vehicle while trying to avoid hitting the stationary trailer.

The Zonal Commander of the Federal Road Safety Commission (FRSC), Mr. Austin Aipoh, confirmed the accident in Ilorin, the state capital.

He also confirmed the arrest of no fewer than 60 vehicles for breaching traffic rules.

He warned drivers, particularly those plying roads in the night, to ensure that their headlights are in good condition.
