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Jos: More bodies found at Dogo Nahawa

More bodies have been discovered at Dogo Nahawa and other villages in Jos South Local Government Area of Plateau State after the mass burial given to hundreds of bodies over two weeks ago.

Twelve bodies have been buried after the mass burial. Nineteen injured persons are still in hospitals

Some bodies have also been picked in surrounding bushes

The claims were made yesterday to reporters by the Shen Community Development Association (SCDA) at a press conference in Jos, the state capital

The association's president, Mr. Rwang Chuwang, said contrary to a report by the police that 109 were killed during the attack on the community by suspected Fulani pastoralists, the community "is still facing the horror of the incident as residents are dying daily due to either multiple cuts or shock".

He added: "We are still counting the dead by the day. More bodies have been discovered after the mass burial. Some of those hospitalised have died. Some families were wiped out."

The community appealed to law enforcement agencies to provide adequate security for the residents.

State House of Assembly Deputy Speaker, Hon. Ibrahim Baba Hassan, yesterday warned religious leaders against inciting sermons.

He urged them to support efforts to return lasting peace to the state.

san condemned, in a statement in Jos, what he described as "up-scaling of violence in Plateau State".

The deputy speaker, therefore, urged clerics to shun provocative "words" in their sermons.

He said: "We can no longer pretend that all is well when we wake up daily to hear of violence and bloodshed.

"What is happening in Plateau State is condemnable. It is also wicked, barbaric and ungodly."

He said perpetrators of violence in the state should bow their heads in shame as consequences of their action had rubbished Nigeria's image

Hassan appealed to the government and people not to give up the search for peace.

"We should not give up on the assumption that since past efforts to achieve peace have failed, then we cannot succeed in finding lasting solution to Plateau crisis.

"The task may seem daunting, but it does not suggest that it cannot be attained," the lawmaker added.
