

Two crushed to death in Delta By Okungbowa Aiwerie | Published 1/04/2010 | News | Unrated

Two persons were yesterday crushed to death in separate road accidents in Ogwashi-Uku, Aniocha South Local Government Area of Delta State.

A young man, whose identity could not be ascertained, was drinking at a roadside palm wine bar at Isah-Ogwashi-Uku when a truck lost control, and smashed into the bar, killing him.

An eyewitness said the driver of the truck lost control, causing one of the tyres to come off

"Many patrons at the bar noticed the truck and scampered to safety but before the young man knew the truck was upon him. The impact killed him instantly.

In another freak accident, a headmaster of a public school in the community was crushed to death after a truck lost control while trying to avoid a head-on collision with a trailer and a parked bus.

The incident took place at Aboh-Ogwashi-Uku.

Also, a young man was killed yesterday, following a clash by rival cult groups in Utulu Community, Aniocha South Local Government Area.

Seven others were said to have been injured.

According to police sources, the motive for the fight has not been established.

An eyewitness said about 30 youths stormed the community, brandishing dangerous weapons and attacked another gang.

learnt that the residents fled as the fighting intensified

The intervention of the police brought the situation under control

Five suspects were arrested.
