

Police arrest three suspects over UNAD students' death

Police arrest three suspects over UNAD students' death

Three suspected cultists are now in the custody of the Ekiti State Police Command over last week's alleged murder of two students of the University of Ado-Ekiti (UNAD).

The victims were reportedly hacked to death last Monday in Dallimore area of Ado-Ekiti, the Ekiti State capital, in a dawn attack that left some residents injured.

The two UNAD students killed in the attack were Akin Adebole and Ayodeji Olasope.

The mother of the latter was said to have witnessed the killing of her son.

The Command's spokesman, Mr. Mohammed Jimoh, an Assistant Superintendent of Police (ASP), said the suspects were arrested at their hideout in Adebayo area of Ado-Ekiti.

Speaking yesterday on phone on the development, Jimoh said two UNAD students, Adebisi Alabi and Femi Melody, have been arrested in connection with the killing.

He said the third suspect, Kareem Ayodeji, is a student of the Ado-Ekiti satellite campus of The Polytechnic, Ibadan .

The police spokesman added that a gun and a machete were recovered from the suspects whom he said would be arraigned in court.

The state police command have arrested a member of an armed robbery gang alleged to operate in Nova area of the state capital.
