

# College student stabs mate to death

**A** STUDENT of the Federal College of Education (Technical), Bichi, in Kano State has allegedly stabbed his roommate to death.

The police have begun investigating the matter.

Trouble started when two students – Sunday Adetayo

and Shaibu Mubarak – were said to have quarreled over a bucket of water.

Eyewitnesses said Mubarak used the water which Adetayo kept under his bed.

They said the development did not go down well with Adetayo, who engaged Mubarak in “hot” argument.

Adetayo grabbed a knife and stabbed Mubarak on his thigh.

Mubarak, the witnesses said, bled to death because he could not get first aid in time.

Immediately Mubarak died, Adetayo attempted to run away, but he was apprehended and handed over to the school security men.

Confirming the incident, the College Provost, Alhaji Ibrahim Jibrin, said the suspect had been handed over to the police.
