Police corporal kills sergeant over N40 bribe

# Police corporal kills sergeant over N40 bribe

A police corporal identified as Abdul Yakubu on Sunday killed a senior police officer, Sergeant Buba <u>Iafar</u>i, at a check point near the Nigeria Institute for Oil Palm Research (NIFOR) on Benin Akure Road over <u>N40</u>.

Sources said an argument ensued between the two officers at the checkpoint over who should control the day's collection from motorists after the first bribe was collected.

An eyewitness, Osaro Igbinovia, told reporters that they saw the sergeant questioning the corporal and that the next thing they heard was a gun shot which killed the sergeant.

Yakubu was said to have been disarmed by other police officers at the check-point from where he was taken to Ekiadolor police station.

Jafari's remains have been deposited at a mortuary in Benin City.

Police spokesman Peter Ogboi, who confirmed the incident, refuted claims that Jafari was shot over <u>brib</u>e collection.

He said an argument ensued after the Yakubu refused to carry out an order given to him by Jafari.
