## 14 die in Enugu-Onitsha Expressway crash

FOURTEEN persons died on Tuesday in an accident on the Enugu-Onitsha Expressway.

A Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) source said the accident occurred at about 6:55pm.

He said the accident involved a <u>Foton Mini bus</u> with registration No. XY212ENU belonging to Peace Mass Transit and a MAN Diesel truck with registration No. XA214NNR.

The bus, which was driving against traffic, collided with the truck.

Enugu FRSC Unit Commander Anyebe Okpe said 14 people including the bus driver died on the spot.

He said the bodies had been taken to the Oji River General Hospital mortuary.


The Commander said: "Two people were injured, but the truck driver escaped unhurt.

"The accident was caused by route violation. Both drivers were over speeding."

Okpe urged drivers to be cautious.
