CONFUSION pervaded the atmosphere in <u>Riyom</u> Local Government Area of <u>Plateau</u> State following the killing of <u>two</u> people by unknown persons in a fresh attack in the area.

The commander of the Special Task Force on Jos crises, Brig. Gen. Hassan Umoru, confirmed it Friday that the incident happened at about 7pm on on Thursday.

According to the JTF commander, two people on a motorcycle shot the victims, who were young men and escaped immediately.

He said: "When the JTF members in

charge of the area were alerted, they gave the attackers a hot chase, but could not arrest them.

"We are still on the trail of the suspects. We have urged the police in charge of Riyom local government to work with youths of the area to continue the search for the suspects."

The attack has heightened tension in the area as youths who suspected the attakers to be Fulani herdsmen have declared war against any Fulani man found in their locality.

But the commander of Task Force has assured that he has deployed enough troops in the area to avoid any reprisal attack from the youths.

Gen. Umoru warned: "Any attempt by anybody to frustrate the efforts that we have put in place towards restoration of permanent peace in the state will be resisted by the task force.

"This kind of attack serves as a draw back to us and we will not continue to condone this. We are planning to come out in full force against people that are not interested in peace".

The victims have since been buried by their families.

What happened in Riyom is a daily occurrence in neighboring Barkin Ladi, especially in Fan where, a week back the villagers had to bury three youths attacked and murdered at different locations by Fulani herdsmen on a hit-and -run mission, from neighboring Ropp District. The Commanders of the JTF need to properly give their men in the villages appropriate orientation to transform them from the mere village terrorists they have become to peace keepers. An example here subsists: One of the soldiers in Radura village of Fan District battered one Da Dung from Lo Fan village, about ten back, over the latter's wife who the soldier has an amorous affair with. The victim now lies between life and death from serious injuries sustained in the hands of the said soldier. This is a case the Commander can easilly verify, from the palace of Gwom Rwey Fan. The villagers are now sandwiched between attacks from itinerant fulani herdsmen and internal servitude and maltreatment form men of the JTF in their midst.
