DISTURBED by the death of six persons believed to be a fall out between two Cult groups, former **Ijaw** Youth Council (IYC) leader. Mr. Maxwell Oko, has condemned the incident that led to the death of **six** people.

His reaction followed the

emergence of more facts on what led to the bloody day at <u>Opokuma</u>, the country home of the former Managing Director of the NDDC, Mr. Timi Alaibe.

Alaibe is contesting for the governorship seat in **Bayelsa** on the platform of the Labour Party (LP).

In a chat with journalists in Yenagoa, Oko who described the incident as an embarrassment to the state and Federal Government accused desperate politicians who have almost turned their rallies into theaters of war to have caused the incident.

The former IYC leader who is now the Commissioner of energy advised them not see politics as a do or die affair, and cautioned youths in the state not to allow themselves to be used.

He urged the security agents in the state to fish out those behind the heinous action and bring them to book.

"I condemn it totally. This is an act of recklessness that was caused by some unknown politicians who are desperate. This is not something Government will seat down and look at. The security agencies should ensure that every person involved is brought to book because we have lost lives of young aspiring youths", the former IYC Central Zone leaders lamented.

Sources disclosed that the gruesome incident at Opokuma Community started in Port Harcourt when Alaibe allegedly invited two suspected cult groups, the Ice Landers and the Green Landers to grace his reception both at the Airport and in Opokuma Community.It was learnt that trouble started at the Port Harcourt airport when T-Shirts and money being shared.

The Port Harcourt incident spread to Opokuma when the aggrieved group whose colleague died in Port Hacourt moved to Opokuma for reprisal attack. When the aggrieved group arrived Opokuma Community they could not spare anything person at sight as they used axes and cutlasses on people.

The State government in a statement expressed dismay over the **violence** that was unleashed on the people of the state by the activities of Mr Ndutimi Alaibe of the Labour Party.

The government said reports indicate that Mr Alaibe left Port Harcourt airport yesterday afternoon Enroute Yenagoa amidst shootings and violent clashes between rival cult groups that reportedly left one person dead.

"Same groups later moved to Opokuma, Mr Alaibe's country home where unprecedented **Violence** was unleashed on the community and visitors including pressmen,most of whom had to run for their lives. Unfortunately, **six** people were reportedly **killed** and scores injured in

spite of the arrival of police and other security personnel on the scene.

"The State Govt view the activities of Mr Alaibe as totally unacceptable and unbecoming of someone of his standing. "We had thought that with his departure from the PDP, such violent incidents will be reduced to the barest minimum as has been the case since the PDP primaries started until he came again, with the guise of a rally to disrupt the peace of the State.
