Six die in road accident

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Six persons, including two expatriates, died on Tuesday in a multiple **accident** at **Agbede**, Estako West Local Government Area of Edo State.

The **accident** involved three trucks and a Toyota Corolla. Two of the victims were burnt beyond recognition.

Sources said the **accident** occurred when a truck, belonging to Petroden Company, collided with a lorry loaded with cement. The truck was carrying asphalt.

The Petroden truck burst into flames.

It was gathered that the driver of the Toyota Corolla was asked to pull over, following the traffic jam when another trailer ran into it.

The occupant of both vehicles were crushed to death.

The two expatriates were said to be travelling to Auchi to open a branch of a new generation bank.

Sector Commander of the Federal **Road** Safety Commission (FRSC) Henry Olatunji said the bodies have been deposited in a mortuary.



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
