# Eight die in another Jos mayhem

Jos, the Plateau State capital, was on the boil again yesterday. What was a minor scuffle at Abuja market in the restive city turned into another mayhem. By the time the dust settled, no fewer than eight people lay dead - one of them, a policeman.

There was pandemonium as people scampered for safety while fear enveloped the city centre. Motorists smashed into one another in a desperate bid to escape the horror that began at the market, located around the Jos Terminus.

Traders at the Terminus quickly closed their shops to avoid looting by hoodlums.

Eyewitness account said trouble started when a policeman in uniform went to buy meat from a Hausa man at the market. An argument, whose cause could not be ascertained, ensued between them. The meat seller allegedly stabbed the policemen who died instantly.

Another meat seller sitting close by allegedly stabbed a lady customer standing before him to death, in retaliation.

Reprisal attacks then followed after which no fewer than eight people were killed.

Burnt bodies littered the Ahmadu Bello way and Gadabiu area of the city.

It was gathered that Muslim youths at the Terminus began preparing to launch an attack following rumours that Christians were planning to attack them in the Massalaci Jumma'a Mosque where they were reciting the Qur'an to mark Prophet Muhammed's birthday.
