

Wife kills husband

A TRAFFIC Constable living on Moshalashi Alao Street, Ifako, Agege has been killed by his wife over a yet to be ascertained domestic quarrel.

The deceased, Abraham Aigbologa, a traffic warden at Iponri Police Station, was allegedly matcheted to death a fortnight ago by his wife, Juliana, who later fled to an unknown destination.

One of the late policeman's sons, Sunday (25), who reported the matter to the police at the Agege Police Station, said he woke up and saw his father in a pool of blood with matchet cuts.

He explained that on the night of the incident, the family had as usual taken their supper and retired to bed.

"My father and his wife went into their room to sleep. There was no noticeable disagreement between them", he said.

He told *CityBeats* that he even approached his father to allow him use his mobile phone to make free night calls which he obliged him.

Sunday said after he had

finished his calls, he slept off only to be woken up by a call on his father's phone at about 9am.

He noted that it was unusual for his father not to have gone to work at that time and so he rushed to his father's room to give him the phone but was shocked to have met him in a pool of blood with matchet cuts.

"I ran to my father's room with the telephone and discovered that the door to the room was

hooked with padlock although it was not locked. I removed the padlock and opened the door only to find my father in a pool of blood with matchet cuts,"he said.

It was learnt that his shouts attracted neighbours who accompanied him to the police station to report the matter.

The police came and removed the corpse which was deposited at the Isolo General Hospital for autopsy.

Sunday told the police that the suspect was not his father's real wife, but rather, the wife of his father's late brother, which the deceased inherited as wife after the brother's death.

The woman was said to have four children for the brother of the deceased, but had no issue for the policeman.

A police source told *CityBeats* that the suspect has fled since the incident and that all efforts to trace her has proved abortive. He, however, asserted but that investigators are not relenting in unearthing her whereabouts.
