## Two killed, many injured as ACN, PDP supporters clash

Two persons were killed and several others injured as supporters of the Peoples Democratic Party (<u>PDP</u>) and Action Congress of Nigeria (ACN) clashed in Ibiono Ibom Local Government Area of Akwa Ibom State.

Sources said incident occurred at the council secretariat, Oko Ita.

They said the <u>PDP supporters allegedly prevented</u> the <u>ACN</u> senatorial candidate, <u>Obong Nsima Umoh</u>, from using the hall.

An eyewitness, Udobong Bassey, said supporters of <u>Ita Enang</u>, <u>Chairman of the House of Representatives' Committee</u> on <u>Business and Rules</u>, prevented Umoh's loyalists from entering the premises.

Several of the injured are receiving treatment at undisclosed hospitals in Ibiono Ibom and neighbouring Uyo.

ACN officials accused a serving commissioner and Enang of sponsoring the attack. But Enang denied, saying he had no reason to sponsor violence.

His words: "I am not aware of the crisis because I have not been properly briefed. My opponent, Obong Nsima Umoh, cannot sponsor it because we have standards of behaviour and I have known him for years."

Police spokesman Onyeka Orji said he was yet to be briefed on the incident.
