Violence erupted in Farin Gada, Jos North Local
Government Area yesterday, leaving seven people dead.

There was a fight in Farin-gada between Christians and Hausa-Fulani settlers around Tomatoes Market.

One Christian boy was allegedly attacked and killed by suspected Hausa Muslim in Farin-Gada.

Some Christian youths in the area protested the killing of their colleague.

Business activities were paralysed, as people were forced to remain indoors. Soldiers patrolled the area. y.
