# Two killed as gunmen kidnap Oshiomhole's aide's mother

The **mother** of an ex-militant leader, who is the Senior Special Assistant to Edo State Governor on Surveillance/Waterways Security, Okubo Robert, has been kidnapped.

Madam Rebecca Robert Edu (75) was abducted by unknown **gunmen** in Inikorogha, Ovia South-West Local Government.

Okubo's aide , Ogaga Sapele, and his younger sister, Faye Ojemba (16), were **killed** during the attack.

Madam Edu has spent more than eight days in captivity, according to family sources.

Narrating his ordeal, Okubo said he led some of his boys to sleep in his family house after a patrol of the waterways.

He said about 12 **gunmen**, armed with AK 47, attacked the house at about 3am on March 20, killing his younger sister and aide.

The ex-militant said the **gunmen** called him, demanding N5 million and the release of their men whose arrest by officials of the State Security Service (SSS) he facilitated.

Okubo lamented that the **gunmen** were still holding his **mother** after collecting N500,000 from him.

He urged security agencies to help in securing his mother's release.

Police spokesman Peter Ogboi said a manhunt for the **gunmen** had begun.
