## **ACN** member killed in Ogoni

A **member** of the Action Congress of Nigeria (<u>ACN</u>) in <u>Loore</u> (**Ogoni**) community, <u>Khana</u> Local Government Area of Rivers State, was yesterday allegedly **killed** by suspected Peoples Democratic Party's (<u>PDP's</u>) thugs, during the governorship and House of Assembly elections.

The **ACN member** was **killed** around 2 pm yesterday over disagreement on the elections.

Rivers police Spokesman Mr. Ben Ugwuegbulam could not confirm the incident.

The Area Commander for Bori, **Ogoni**, Mr. Anthony Ogboji said he was monitoring elections in Port Harcourt, the state capital and would reach the area's DPO for confirmation.

**ACN** governorship candidate in Rivers Abiye Sekibo alleged massive rigging by the ruling PDP.

Sekibo, in a telephone interview, said after the collation and if the irregularities and violence affect the credibility of the elections, the opposition party would reject the results of the elections outright.

The ACN's standard bearer, who spoke through his campaign organisation's Director of Publicity and Communications, Mr. Jerry Needam, said agents of the party were also chased away from the Khana LGA's collation centre at the council's headquarters in Bori, **Ogoni** by soldiers and riot policemen.
