Five killed in Bayelsa 'cult clash' From Isaac Ombe,

Yenagoa IVE persons were reportedly killed yesterday in Yenagoa, the

Bayelsa State capital, during a clash between suspected cult groups. The clash occurred at 8pm

near the main motor park in the Ekeki area. Those killed were said to

passersby who were caught in thé exchange of fire between the rival cult groups. Evewitnesses said one of the rival cultists ambushed the other at the motor park and began shooting. In the

melee, passersby in the busy park were hit by bullets. The police reportedly erected a road block where vehicles and Okada riders that

passed the place were frisked. The residents retired into

their homes early as a result of the shooting. spokesman, Police Emokpae Egwavon, an Assistant Superintendent of Police (ASP), could not con-

firm the incident. He said many people had called him over the shooting, promising that he would get details today. A similar shooting occurred last Sunday night in

a bar near Okutukutu, Yenagoa where five people were killed .
