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Man shoots friend while hunting

A man, Musibau Mustapha (30), has killed his friend, Sunday Ijasa, in Igbara-Odo, Ekiti State.

Mustapha allegedly committed the crime on August 5 while hunting with the deceased.

He is being interrogated at the Police Headquarters in Ado-Ekiti, the state capital.

Police spokesman Victor Olu-Babayemi said Mustapha said "he mistook his friend for an antelope".

Olu-Babayemi said: "While interrogating him, there were inconsistencies in his admissions. These make him a suspect."

He said an autopsy had been done on the deceased and Mustapha would be arraigned soon.

Olu-Babayemi said a car-snatching gang, allegedly led by Ajayi Gbenga and Fatoki Olabode, was arrested on June 28 by the Special Anti-Robbery Squad (SARS).

He said a Toyota Sienna space bus, marked TY 575 KJA, and a Toyota Camry salon car, numbered BZ 567 AGL, were recovered from the suspects.

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
