Deposed Oyo chief held for 'murder' From Oseheye Okwuofu, Ibadan HE deposed Baale of Agudu in Oyo State, Molike Ogunsanya, and two others have been arrested by the police for allegedly killing Saheed Ogundele (25) last Thursday. Ogunsanya was deposed by the Olubadan and replaced with Chief Tajudeen Adeyemo. Police spokesperson Olabisi Clet-Ilobanafor said the suspects, who are being held at the State Criminal Investigation Department (CID) in Iyaganku, Ibadan, would be charged to court when er the police conclude their investigation. It was learnt that the late Ogundele was on a motorcycle with two of his friends when a Sport Utility Vehicle (SUV) parked in front of them. on Mr. Yemi Onifade, who as was riding the motorcy-cle, said: "The SUV ve nparked in front of us and ut its four occupants orit. dered us not to move. ck le Suddenly, thugs overwhelmed us, wielding of cutlasses and axes. One d of them dragged d Ogundele down from the nt motorcycle. g "We were still at a fix, ge when one baba (Ogunsanya), who sat in 1 front of the SUV holding a gun, shot at us. I and the third person (Mr. Jide Adewale) ran into the bush. Later, we heard Ogundele crying aloud for help. When Adewale and I came out of hiding, we found Ogundele rolling on the ground of and bleeding. We took un him to Akanran Police Station and some policemen accompanied us to Bembo Hospital, where the doctor told us he was dead." It was gathered that Ogunsanya and some members of the community were fighting over a parcel of land.
