Police 'kill' driver in Edo

A MIDDLE-AGED man, Osagie Egbon, has been allegedly shot dead by yet-to-be-identified policemen in Edo State.

Osagie was killed about 7pm on Saturday at Ikpoba-slope.

His body has been deposited at the Central Hospital mortuary.

Witnesses said Osagie, like other drivers, took the wrong lane because of a traffic jam, while the police were coming from the opposite direction.

They said the police shot into the air to make way for easy passage, while other sources said they were yet to understand the rationale behind the shooting.

Police spokesman Moses Eguavoen said in a statement that the policemen were yet to be identified.

He said investigations were ongoing.
