Suspected robbers arrested in Lagos

HE police in Lagos have arrested four illegal aliens, suspected to be armed robbers.

Police spokesperson Ngozi Braide said the suspects were arrested in Ikoyi on Monday about 2am in a Honda Accord car with registration number

FV 846 LSR.

She said a police team, attached to the Ikoyi Division, while on patrol on Lugard Avenue, Ikoyi, arrested the suspects and recovered a dagger, two cutlasses, three pliers, four fez caps, ropes and charms.

The suspects, Ibrahim A., Ibrahim Solu, Rafiu Guja and Hassan Abba, who are Shuarab indigenes from Chad Republic and security guards at Ikoyi, were said to have confessed that they were going for a robbery in Ikoyi.

Police said they were making efforts to arrest other members of the gang.
