Emir of Ilorin loses daughter

THE death has occurred yesterday of Hajiya Saratu Sulu-Gambari, daughter of the Emir of Ilorin, Zulkarnaini Sulu-Gambari.

Hajiya Sulu-Gambari (49) died at the Ahmadu Bello University Teaching Hospital (ABUTH), Zaria, following an accident on the Zaria-Kano Road.

A source said she was on her way to Kano for a condolence visit with a maid when their vehicle rammed into a stationary trailer.

The maid was said to have died on the spot while the driver sustained minor bruises.

"Hajiya's head was badly hurt. She became unconscious and was immediately rushed to ABUTH, where she was put on oxygen. She died hours later.

The late Sulu-Gambari was the widow of Kaduna business mogul Lawal Baloni, who died three years ago.

She is survived by five children- Maryam, Aishatu, Mukhtar, Jummai and Sark
