HE Plateau State Police Command has said it is winning the battle against criminal elements across the state.

Making the revelation during his quarterly briefing at the Command's headquarters in Jos, the Commissioner of Police, Chris Olakpe said: "We have been able to net in some dare-devil criminals in the last two months and we feel we should let the public know of these wolfs in sheep clothing."

Continuing on the exploits of his men,
Olakpe said: "There was a case of criminal
conspiracy and culpable homicide
involving five suspects. On the 14th of
March 2014, one Sidi Suleiman of
Nasarawa Gwong, Jos, reported at the C
Division Police Station that his son was
attacked and killed by one Abdulrazak
Idris and four others.

"He gave the name of his son as Khalid Saidi, aged 20. One of the suspects, Abdulrazak Idris, was arrested while disguising as a female to beat security check point. The police is on the trail of the four other suspects who are now at large, while investigation continues."

The police also arrested a man who allegedly sold his son for N350, 000. The man later led the police to the buyer who
