## Couple, children die in road crash

**A** MAN identified  
as Jabari  
Adewale, his  
wife and their two chil-  
dren have died in a  
motor accident on the  
Owo-Ikare road at Ago  
Eleye, near Oba Akoko.

The accident occurred  
at the weekend when the  
car conveying the de-  
ceased collided with a  
truck parked by the  
roadside, killing all the  
occupants instantly.

It was gathered that  
the couple and their two  
children were travelling  
to their village.

A Unit Commander of  
the Federal Road Safety  
Commission (FRSC), Mr.  
David Ogundana, said  
the accident was as a  
result of dangerous  
driving and loss of  
control by the car's  
driver.

He added that those  
involved in the crash  
included two male  
adults, one female adult  
and four female chil-  
dren.

He said the deceased  
family were driving a  
Toyota Camry with  
registration number AP  
208 FDD, which rammed  
into a truck marked LSD
