Three remanded for murder in Ogun

THREE men- Fatai Lamidi, Muyideen Salaudeen and Oyeyemi Semiu- were arraigned yesterday before an Ilaro Magistrate's Court for the alleged murder of Olufemi Amosun(21).

The victim was reportedly murdered when Governor Ibikunle Amosun visited the town during a tour of the Yewa South Local Government.

The suspects were subsequently remanded in prison custody and charged with murder, illegal possession of firearms, conspiracy, among others.

Femi was killed when supporters of two rival National Assembly aspirants clashed.

Several others were injured. Seven suspects were arrested and four pump action guns and other weapons recovered from them.

When the case was mentioned, no plea was taken. Chief Magistrate M. Fafowora adjourned till November 16.
