Woman charged with manslaughter

A WOMAN, Funmilola Oyetunji, has been arraigned at an Osogbo Magistrate's Court for alleged manslaughter.

She was charged with reckless driving, which caused the death of five-year-old Banji Ishola and injured his grandmother, Taiwo Olumide.

The accused reportedly committed the offence on September 29, at Ofatedo Junction, Dada Estate, Osogbo.

The prosecutor, Fagboyinbo Abiodun, a police inspector, told the court that she drove recklessly, thereby causing the accident. Mrs. Oyetunji pleaded not guilty.

The defence counsel, Teju Kolawole, urged the court to grant his client bail.

The Magistrate, M.A. Lasisi, granted her bail of N500,000 and two sureties. The judge said the sureties must be her husband and one of her parents.

He adjourned the case till January 26.
